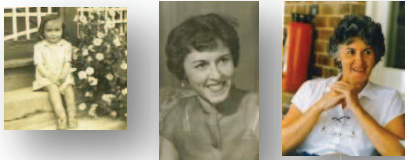

ABC - One of the first things you learn in school.

IDEGEIKO –Put kicks, stances & punches into basic combinations

SENTENCES – Combine your words into sentences.

KATA – Combine your various Idegeiko combinations into set forms & patterns to develop mental stimulation, improve co-ordination, timing, balance, strength etc.

CONVERSATION – Put your sentences into conversation, done properly you will have various conversations with people in your lifetime.

FIGHTING – If you practise your basics & put them altogether properly, you will have a great fighting conversation with various Karate ka in your lifetime.
